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The Vijnanabharathi Vidyajyothi Scholarship Curriculum is an informal educational program that combines ancient and modern knowledges and scientific discoveries on the basis of the rich Indian educational tradition.

# Introduction

This informal education initiative is characterized by a systematic syllabus and a competitive exam that will be beneficial for students from the level of kindergarten to post-graduation, teachers, parents, and all curious knowledge-seekers.

This course of study is open for anyone irrespective of age and the competitive exam can be written by anyone from the age of four to the end of one's lifetime. Such a course and examination are exceptional and never-seen before.



# Features

This course helps to achieve the goals intended by education that cannot be achieved through the existing formal education system and exams. This also includes brain-power improving techniques, techniques to enhance interest in the subject being studied, study secrets, memory boosting strategies, and tips to excel in exams, that will be a relief to students struggling with the 'syllabus burden'.




Curriculum with 15 levels starting from age 4 to end of one's lifetime.  
No age limit.

Scholarship exams at all levels! 100 toppers at each level; (15 x 100 = 1500) toppers will be felicitated in a public ceremony.

The top 10 or 20 in each level will be given monthly scholarships for ten months, from level 1 to level 14. Monthly scholarships for 12 months for top 10 or 20 rankers in level 15.

Course and exam are open not only for students but also for parents, teachers, and interested people.



# Cumulative Syllabus

The Vidyajyothi scholarship program is not just an objective type exam based on general knowledge and current affairs as is the case with many exams. The lessons are organized in a very simple format, starting from introductory lessons, covering more than 100 topics under 80 subjects over three terms. Questions are prepared based on a scientific and systematic syllabus in a cumulative manner. The study and exam on each level will cover questions based on the syllabus of all its lower levels. For example, UKG question paper will include topics from LKG. The questions based on topics of both these classes will be included in the 1st Std level. And so on until 15th level (Higher) will include questions on topics of all the 14 levels below it.

# How much is the fees?

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **Who can participate?**

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Anyone above the age of 4 and above till 120 years of age. Students, teachers, professionals, parents, homemakers, grandparents; anyone who has a keen interest in enriching their knowledge.

## **The course is cumulative. So should I pay separately for all the levels below my selected level?**

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No. You pay only for the level you have selected. For example, if you are enrolling in the 8th Std level, you pay Rs 550 and all the content of the levels below 8th std will be accessible to you.

## **Are the lessons available in printed format?**

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Yes. Additional charges will be applicable.

## **Can I enroll for the course and study the course without appearing in the examination?**

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Yes. The examination is optional. However, there is no discount in the fees for skipping the examination. No partial or full refund will be issued in case the registered person does not appear in the examination.

# Scholarships

## **Award Ceremony**

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100 toppers from each of the 15 levels (from LKG to Higher) will be felicitated in a public ceremony.

A total of  $15 \times 100 = 1500$  people will be awarded.

Some of the top scorers in the exam will be awarded by eminent personalities in an award ceremony.

## **Scholarship from June 2024 onwards**

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Of the top 100, the first 10 or 20 rankers will get a monthly scholarship along with the award.

The scholarship will be for a period of 10 months from June 2024 to March 2025 for 14 levels from LKG to plus 2 level.

The scholarship will be given for 12 months from June 2024 to May 2025 for higher category.






